

RSC WiFi/Internet Policy for Trial 2022

Purpose

The Club may provide WiFi and internet access for its members to enable them to enjoy personal use and for business purposes. The purpose of this policy is to define what the Club considers appropriate usage of the internet and how access to the internet will be managed and monitored.

Organisational Scope

This policy applies to all Club members, staff, contractors and visitors to the club.

Definitions

Computer - includes any electronic device connected to the Clubs networks, which is capable of accessing the internet.

Internet usage - For the purpose of this policy internet usage includes accessing websites, email, peer to peer networking and data sharing and "internet" has a corresponding meaning.

Inappropriate material - Is material which could reasonably be described as unsuitable or offensive having regard to the family nature of the Club and includes material which is pornographic or is otherwise objectionable.

Content

1. General

Any user of the clubs Wifi network must not

- Download or upload obscene, offensive or illegal material.
- Download or upload movies, music and other copyrighted material and software.
- Visit potentially dangerous websites that can compromise the safety of our network and computers.
- Perform unauthorized or illegal actions, like hacking, fraud, buying/selling illegal goods
- Introduce malicious software onto the Clubs network and/or jeopardizing the security of the Clubs electronic communications systems

If parents choose to allow their children access to the Clubs Wifi then Parents are responsible for their children's usage.

The club has a limited bandwidth available for users, and the more users connected to the internet the less bandwidth each individual will have.

For this reason, we ask that members **do not** stream video, movies, TV etc as this will likely bring everyone's connection to a standstill.

2. Blocking Access to Certain Websites

The Club may restrict access to or block certain categories of website that is deemed inappropriate.

3. Monitoring and Enforcement

The club may monitor the usage by users and may suspend individuals, some, or all users if it believes that users have breached the policy, acted in a way that may bring the Club's reputation into disrepute, or potentially compromised the Club's network and its operational useability for Club purposes.

As this is initially intended as a trial, this may be terminated for any reason at any time the Club determines.

The club reserves the right to refuse access to the service, or block access by any person, for any reason. The club is under no obligation to explain why this has been refused, or offer any other service in place of.

Club offers no guarantee of availability or performance of the Wi-Fi, nor does it offer on call "Tech Support" to any members having trouble connecting to, or using the Wi-Fi.

The availability of any wifi or internet service is entirely at the club's discretion and may be terminated for any reason at any time the Club determines.
